Flags criteria:

- No plain text featured for these reasons:
 - 1. Text is unreadable when the flag is small, reversed, in a distance, or waving.
 - 2. To avoid giving preference to the language the text written in, to retain an essence of neutrality.
- No ethnic/religious symbols featured to maintain neutrality.
- Follows the main Moroccan national flag:
 - 1. The flag width-to-length ratio is 2:3.
 - 2. Simplicity over complexity: easy to draw.
 - 3. Single-colored background.
 - 4. A device at the center with a distinct color.

Flag of Tanger-Tétouan-Al Hoceïma


The flag's device is inspired by the traditional striped clothes found exclusively in this region, featuring its eight administrative prefectures.







Flag of The Oriental


The background-color represents the region's landscape which is overwhelmingly influenced by forests of *cladium mariscus* (*Ḥelfa*) plants.


The device is basically eight curved lines referring to the region's administrative prefectures, shaping a wave that symbolize the region's famous beaches, the blue-colored four lines designate the moisty northern prefectures compared to the drought southern ones presented by outlining.




Cladium Mariscus



Flag of Fes-Meknes


The background-color represents the region's status as one of the most important agricultural poles on the national level.




Balgha stitch



Flag of Rabat-Sale-Kenitra


The background-color, the most visible color of the spectrum, reflects the region's status of containing the country's capital.






Béni Mellal-Khénifra



Flag of Beni Mellal-Khenifra


The background-color represents the region's legacy of fortresses and monuments having a yellowish color.


The device is five connected circles representing the region's provinces, which forms a shape like the phosphate molecule as the region holds 33% of the world's phosphate reserves.




A Phosphate Molecule



Flag of Casablanca-Settat


The background-color represents the region's location on the Atlantic coast, the river of Oum Er-rbia that divide the region into two plains and many reservoirs that provide water for the region.


The device is simply a helm representing the region status as the kingdom's industrial, commercial, and financial wheel, it refers also to it possession of one of the largest ports for export and import in North Africa. The wheel's eight rounded peaks plus the circle in the middle represents the region's prefectures and provinces. Its white color inspired from the region's largest city's name: *Casablanca* (The white house)







Flag of Marrakesh-Safi


The background-color represents the region's fish wealth, especially in Safi, which considered the fishing capital.



Mt Toubkal Summit





The background-color is inspired by the paint of the buildings in the region.


The device, a palm tree, represents the desert environment, the oases, and the fruits mainly harvested from this tree in this region, it has five branches that represents the provinces of the region.



Tamegroute Pottery





Flag of Souss-Massa




The background-color is inspired by the color of the Argania seed it represents uniqueness and success.



The background color is inspired by the color of the region's soil, in reference to its archaeological and ethnographic heritage.


The device refers to the region's role as a crossroads between North and South, creating an environment of ethnic and cultural mixing between its three elements, Berber, Arab and African.


It is colored in white as a symbol of peace.







Flag of Laâyoune-Sakia El Hamra


The flag is inspired by the traditional local attire, generally found in both regions in the Sahara, although this one has a unique white cloth.



Flag of Dakhla-Oued Ed-Dahab




