Seating





ELBOWS ON THE TABLE

This is always acceptable. In fact, in the United States it is considered highly improper to let your elbows leave the table at any time during a meal.



PASSING

Everybody knows that the shortest distance between two points is a straight line. So I recommend the forward pass. Bonus points if the food makes it into the intended recipient's mouth. (Not recommended for passing hot grease.)

THE PROPER USE OF UTENSILS

Utensils can be useful from time to time. For example, say your little sister is trying to grab a roll off your plate; a fork comes in very handy. Also, spoons make excellent launch pads. And, of course, steak knives are great for flossing after meals

CHEWING

(As you may have noticed, some essential food items did not fit properly in the four main food groups, but since we figured they're of vital nutritional value, we've assigned them subgroups of their own.)




