





Instructions:

- Remove this insert from the comic book by opening the staples.
- Using scissors or a hobby knife, cut along the dotted line that separates these instructions from the frame.

- Take your chosen photograph and place it so it can be seen through the hole in the TV. Then secure it in place on the back of the frame with sticky tape.
- Cut along the dotted lines of the photo frame stand and fold it toward you along the vertical line where it says "FOLD HERF."
- 6. Fold the frame away from you along the right side of the art where it says "FOLD HERE." Using double-sided sticky tape or glue, secure the back of the frame to the front.
- Stand your frame up on your favorite horizontal surface using the handy support stand.


